Supernatural Seed Abundant Harvest

2 Corinthians 9:10 (NLT) “For God is the one who provides seed for the farmer and then bread to eat. In the same way, he will provide and increase your resources and then produce a great harvest of generosity in you.”

2 Corinthians 9:10 (KJV) “Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your righteousness;)”

We need to start to understand that God is in the multiplying business in everything that you do. Sometimes we give out of the wrong motive and forget about increasing our righteousness.

When you are putting God first, His blessings will overtake you. You will not be able to even run fast enough to get away from them because they will pass you right by.

1 Chronicles 29:1-4 “¹Furthermore David the king said unto all the congregation, Solomon my son, whom alone God hath chosen, is yet young and tender, and the work is great: for the palace is not for man, but for the LORD God. ²Now I have prepared with all my might for the house of my God the gold for things to be made of gold, and the silver for things of silver, and the brass for things of brass, the iron for things of iron, and wood for things of wood; onyx stones, and stones to be set, glistering stones, and of divers colours, and all manner of precious stones, and marble stones in abundance. ³Moreover, because I have set my affection to the house of my God, I have of mine own proper good, of gold and silver, which I have given to the house of my God, over and above all that I have prepared for the holy house. ⁴Even three thousand talents of gold, of the gold of Ophir, and seven thousand talents of refined silver, to overlay the walls of the houses withal”

King David honored Solomon by taking up an offering for Solomon before David died.

God wants us to give out of the right heart. He wants us to give out of a willing and cheerful heart, pursuing God.

“Why are you bring your lesser to the Lord?” Bring your best to Him.

King David’s affection was to the Lord. His heart was right and he wanted to bless the Lord with his giving.

They do things Big in Texas, but God does it BIGGER! King David gave over \$4 billion worth of gold in the offering that he took up for Solomon. Because he pursued God and used wisdom to make his money, David was able to give one half a ton of gold as a result of his obedience.

Malachi 3:10 “Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.”

When God gives financial ideas (or other ideas), it opens you up; when you act on those idea, you allow supernatural results to enter into your life. Open up and stay in God's economy. "Your faith will move mountains." When you decide to live in God's economy you will still have tribulations but those trials will make you stronger in the Lord. When it's too tough for the world, it's just right for you. Remember: whatever you hang around, that spirit will get on you.

1 Chronicles 29:6-17 ⁶Then the chief of the fathers and princes of the tribes of Israel and the captains of thousands and of hundreds, with the rulers of the king's work, offered willingly, ⁷And gave for the service of the house of God of gold five thousand talents and ten thousand drams, and of silver ten thousand talents, and of brass eighteen thousand talents, and one hundred thousand talents of iron. ⁸And they with whom precious stones were found gave them to the treasure of the house of the LORD, by the hand of Jehiel the Gershonite. ⁹Then the people rejoiced, for that they offered willingly, because with perfect heart they offered willingly to the LORD: and David the king also rejoiced with great joy. ¹⁰Wherefore David blessed the LORD before all the congregation: and David said, Blessed be thou, LORD God of Israel our father, for ever and ever. ¹¹Thine, O LORD is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty: for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is thine; thine is the kingdom, O LORD, and thou art exalted as head above all. ¹²Both riches and honour come of thee, and thou reignest over all; and in thine hand is power and might; and in thine hand it is to make great, and to give strength unto all. ¹³Now therefore, our God, we thank thee, and praise thy glorious name. ¹⁴But who am I, and what is my people, that we should be able to offer so willingly after this sort? for all things come of thee, and of thine own have we given thee. ¹⁵For we are strangers before thee, and sojourners, as were all our fathers: our days on the earth are as a shadow, and there is none abiding. ¹⁶O LORD our God, all this store that we have prepared to build thee an house for thine holy name cometh of thine hand, and is all thine own. ¹⁷I know also, my God, that thou triest the heart, and hast pleasure in uprightness. As for me, in the uprightness of mine heart I have willingly offered all these things: and now have I seen with joy thy people, which are present here, to offer willingly unto thee."

David's mind has been opened to God's way. When we don't get attached to something it is easier to let go of it. Remember that all the money in the world truly belongs to the Lord. When remembering this, it becomes very easy to give back to the Lord.

When you say that you are called to finances the Kingdom of God, you will have trials to see if you are true. But remember that wealth transfers never look like wealth transfers. (Ex: Children of Israel in Egypt left will all the riches of Egypt.) Do not get discouraged of God gives you plan and it looks like nothing is there.

"Don't despise the day of small beginnings" -Job 8:7

Proverbs 13:22 "A good man leaveth an inheritance to his children's children: and the wealth of the sinner is laid up for the just."

Ecclesiastes 2:26 “For God giveth to a man that is good in his sight wisdom, and knowledge, and joy: but to the sinner he giveth travail, to gather and to heap up, that he may give to him that is good before God. This also is vanity and vexation of spirit.”

There will be a wealth transfer.

Job 22:22-25 “²²Receive, I pray thee, the law from his mouth, and lay up his words in thine heart. ²³If thou return to the Almighty, thou shalt be built up, thou shalt put away iniquity far from thy tabernacles. ²⁴Then shalt thou lay up gold as dust, and the gold of Ophir as the stones of the brooks. ²⁵Yea, the Almighty shall be thy defence, and thou shalt have plenty of silver.”

Job 25:16-17 “¹⁶Though he heap up silver as the dust, and prepare raiment as the clay; ¹⁷He may prepare it, but the just shall put it on, and the innocent shall divide the silver.”

James 5:1-4 “¹Go to now, ye rich men, weep and howl for your miseries that shall come upon you. ²Your riches are corrupted, and your garments are motheaten. ³Your gold and silver is cankered; and the rust of them shall be a witness against you, and shall eat your flesh as it were fire. Ye have heaped treasure together for the last days. ⁴Behold, the hire of the labourers who have reaped down your fields, which is of you kept back by fraud, crieth: and the cries of them which have reaped are entered into the ears of the Lord of sabaoth.”

The money of the ungodly is crying out to be used by God.
