**Supernatural Seed**  
**Abundant Harvest**  
*Sow It and God Will Grow It pt. 2*

**Genesis 8:22** “While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease.”

**Philippians 4:15-19** “<sup>15</sup>Now ye Philippians know also, that in the beginning of the gospel, when I departed from Macedonia, no church communicated with me as concerning giving and receiving, but ye only. <sup>16</sup>For even in Thessalonica ye sent once and again unto my necessity. <sup>17</sup>Not because I desire a gift: but I desire fruit that may abound to your account. <sup>18</sup>But I have all, and abound: I am full, having received of Epaphroditus the things which were sent from you, an odor of a sweet smell, a sacrifice acceptable, well pleasing to God. <sup>19</sup>But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.”  
Giving starts a cycle that receiving completes. God will only give out of His riches according to our giving. He will provide all of your needs because of your planting/sowing into His kingdom.

**Mark 4:26** “And he said, So is the kingdom of God, as if a man should cast seed into the ground;”  
This is how God’s economy works. It’s nothing more than sowing a reaping.

A heart or soul that hears the promises of God, plants to see others be blessed with the expectation of the harvest, will reap 30, 60, and 100 fold.

**Mark 4:26-28** “<sup>26</sup>And he said, So is the kingdom of God, as if a man should cast seed into the ground; <sup>27</sup>And should sleep, and rise night and day, and the seed should spring and grow up, he knoweth not how. <sup>28</sup>For the earth bringeth forth fruit of herself; first the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear.”

**Galatians 6:9** “And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.”

God is able to multiply your seed sown. Our responsibility after we plant is to give thanksgiving and to go about the Master’s business.

**Proverbs 11:24-25** “<sup>24</sup> One man gives freely, yet gains even more; another withholds unduly, but comes to poverty. <sup>25</sup> A generous man will prosper; he who refreshes others will himself be refreshed.”

You sow it and God will grow it! (You do not have to do the growing!) Always seek God first even over your harvest.

**2 Corinthians 9:6** “Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously.”

We need to have the attitude and desire for someone else to be blessed when we give. Discipline is to lead to restoration.

His gifts and callings are without repentance. He doesn't change His mind about us. God will always provide seed for the sower.

**Luke 6:38** “Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.”

When you give, give out of the right motives. Not for your own benefit, but so that someone else can be blessed.
