Knowing the Time of Your Visitation

Romans 12:1-2 “I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.”

Whenever we meditating on God’s Word, there will be an inward change that brings an outward change in our life.

We should always be thinking, “I will finish what God has called for me to do.”

Ephesians 2:10 (Amp) “For we are God’s [own] handiwork (His workmanship), recreated in Christ Jesus, [born anew] that we may do those good works which God predestined (planned beforehand) for us [taking paths which He prepared ahead of time], that we should walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us to live].”

God’s greatest display of power always comes in your darkest hour.

2 Timothy 1:9 “Who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began,”

Your destiny is beckoning to you solemnly.

Isaiah 54:12 (Message)

“Clear lots of ground for your tents!
Make your tents large. Spread out! Think big!
Use plenty of rope,
drive the tent pegs deep.
You’re going to need lots of elbow room
for your growing family.”

Those who are launching out to do what God has told you to do, do not hold back!!! You will not be embarrassed. God will work through your life and make you succeed.

In our storms, God is still working in our lives.

Luke 19:42-44 “42 Saying, If thou hadst known, even thou, at least in this thy day, the things which belong unto thy peace! but now they are hid from thine eyes. 43 For the days shall come upon thee, that thine enemies shall cast a trench about thee, and compass thee round, and keep thee in on every side, 44 And shall lay thee even with the ground, and thy children within thee; and they shall not leave in thee one stone upon another; because thou knewest not the time of thy visitation.”

In the verse above, “visitation” means that God’s glory will be dripping off of you! God will make you succeed!

Time is relentless. We can lose our season of opportunity if we do not watch out for it. It is never too late with Jesus, but we can waste our life away.

In the end, our vacations/trips/work/holidays, will not matter. The only thing that will matter is the mark that we leave behind for God’s kingdom.

Through the Holy Spirit, Jesus Christ and God are working in you. They are here to enable you. If you do not accomplish something that is bigger than yourself and your own ability, then God was not a big part of your life.

Hebrews 2:1 “Therefore we ought to give the more earnest heed to the things which we have heard, lest at any time we should let them slip.”

Get addicted to God’s plan for you. We can drift by our point of purpose if we do not take heed to it.

Act 20:24 “But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God.”

If we are always chasing our fleshly desires, then we might miss the Will of God. We should lay down our wants for the Will of God. It is better to have little, and achieve God’s plan, than to have much, and do nothing for God’s will.

Hebrews 12:2-3 (Message) “1-3Do you see what this means—all these pioneers who blazed the way, all these veterans cheering us on? It means we'd better get on with it. Strip down, start running—and never quit! No extra spiritual fat, no parasitic sins. Keep your eyes on Jesus, who both began and finished this race we're in. Study how he did it. Because he never lost sight of where he was headed—that exhilarating finish in and with God—he could put up with anything along the way: Cross, shame, whatever. And now he's there, in the place of honor, right alongside God. When you find yourselves flagging in your faith, go over that story again, item by item, that long litany of hostility he plowed through. That will shoot adrenaline into your souls!”
